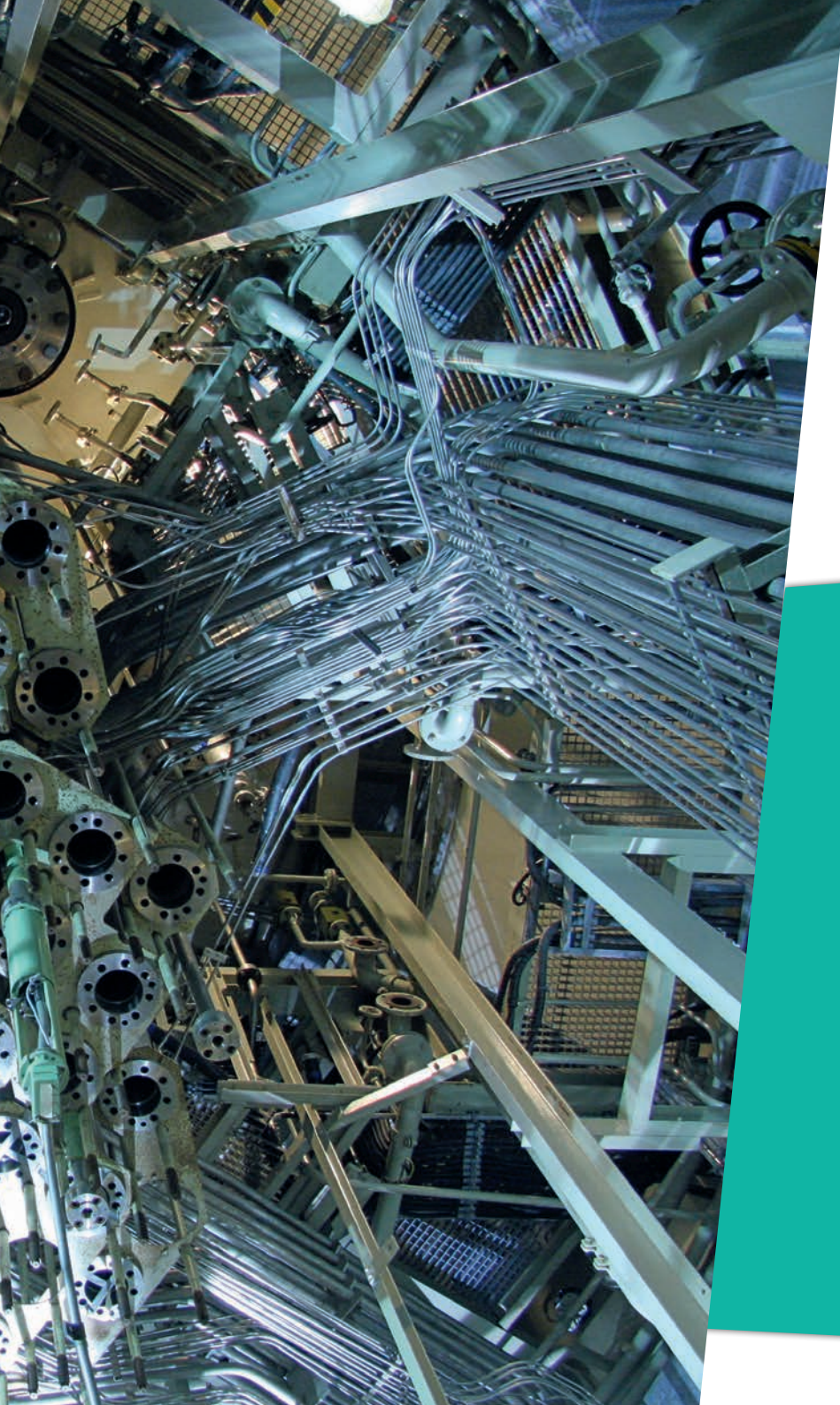
WELCOME TO THE CRADLE OF SMiRT
